MAHN's Food Resource Program Highlights 2022

MontCo Anti-Hunger Network's Food Resource Program coordinates food donations to Montgomery County's Food Safety Network of food pantries and soup kitchens. We focus on increasing the volume of nutritious food available to those in need.

HOW IT WORKS











Food becomes available through regional providers, retail rescue pick ups, and network transfers of donated products through pantry to pantry sharing.

Food is picked up weekly by MAHN following safe food handling procedures and delivered directly to soup kitchens and food pantries on a "take what you need basis" so nothing gets wasted.

Food stays local and has an immediate, positive impact on the community. The stress of soliciting and logistics behind large scale food donations are eliminated for the network.

In addition to the items below, MAHN distributes paper products, cleaning supplies, and personal protection equipment when available.




