












Our Work






Census Tract **Poverty Rate**




Municipal Boundary


Running out of food




Percentage of perishable food




Produce from garden programs




Grocers Against Hunger (GAH)




GAH and Vehicles




Refrigeration Capacity










Ability to Attend Meetings
